ARUN MONGA, J.

Present regular second appeal has been preferred by the plaintiff-appellant having suffered concurrent findings rendered by the Courts below whereby the trial Court had dismissed the suit vide judgment and decree dated 29.05.1989, for possession by way of pre-emption being the co-sharer of property sold by another co-sharer. Subsequently in the first appeal the said judgment and decree was upheld on 29.05.1990. The appeal was filed sometime in the year 1990 and was admitted vide order dated 25.09.1990 when no interim stay was granted. Given sheer efflux of time for more than 30 years as the original suit was instituted on 07.05.1986, this Court is of the opinion that the relief sought by the appellant herein has been rendered infructuous.
