[1] Result of the petitioner has been produced in a sealed cover in Court today which on opening reveals the petitioner to have secured 98 marks out of 116 in the written examination and 14 marks out of 24 in the viva voce, total 112 marks out of 200 as against 113/117 marks of the last selected candidate for the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 for UHBVNL/DHBVNL respectively under the General Category. However, candidates having secured 112 marks have been shown in the waiting list in the result published by the respondents on 06.01.2020.

[2] Result of the petitioner as well as cut-off marks of the last selected candidate have been shown to the learned counsel for the petitioner

who on perusal states that the writ petition may be disposed of by directing

the respondents to take follow-up action qua the result declared on 06.01.2020 in accordance with law.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents state that they have no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow-up action in view of the declaration of the revised result of the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 of UHBVNL/DHBVNL qua the petitioner in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
