Though the maintainability of this petition is in doubt, as it arises out of an order passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sonapat appointing a local commissioner for carrying out demarcation by the revenue authorities, but since no objections can be entertained against the report of the local commissioner, then the petitioner cannot be denied his right to cross-examine the local commissioner in the witness-box.

Indisputably, the case is posted for rebuttal and final arguments. When the report of the local commissioner is brought on record, the learned trial Court will provide an opportunity of cross-examination to the petitioner/defendant before he proceeds to hear final arguments.

With this protection, the instant petition stands disposed of.
