The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 2, dated 29.01.2019, under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that a totally concocted version has been put forth by the complainant in the FIR in question and false allegations have been levelled only to wreak vengeance on account of the divorce petition pending between them.

However, perusal of the FIR reveals that specific and serious allegations have been levelled against the accused including the petitioner qua maltreatment and demand of dowry.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
