Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the order dated 07.11.2015(Annexure P-5) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Ludhiana, whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that pursuant to the order dated November 28, 2019, petitioner has surrendered/appeared before the trial court at Ludhiana and has been admitted on interim bail. He states that the petitioner further undertakes to appear before the trial court to face trial in accordance with law.

Since the petitioner has surrendered/appeared before the trial court and has been admitted on interim bail, the present petition is allowed and the order dated November 28, 2019 is hereby made absolute.
