Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an affidavit has been filed in compliance of order dated 30.01.2020.

Thus, the requirement of Central Board of Secondary Education stands fulfilled.

The grievance of the petitioner is that his father's name is being wrongly reflected in the Secondary School Examination Certificate of the petitioner. His father does not use surname 'Dhaliwal' and thus, he wants to get the said surname deleted. The application made in this regard has been wrongly rejected.

On 30.01.2020, learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submitted that in case father of the petitioner files an affidavit that no civil or criminal liability is attached with the name 'Surinder Singh Dhaliwal', his client has no objection in making the correction sought.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 1 submits that he is not aware whether an affidavit has been filed or not.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 1 to correct the certificate in accordance with the submission of the petitioner in case the affidavit mention hereinabove has actually been filed and received. The needful be done within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
