Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and not to interfere in their peaceful married life at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

On 25.02.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, she has produced statements of the petitioners and respondent No.4. Petitioners, in their statements recorded by the police, have stated that they have no danger to their life. They expressed that they do not need any protection from the police.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
