Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.319 dated 20.08.2019 registered under Section 4 of Muslim Woman (Protection of the right on Marriage) at Police Station Hathin District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR in question on the basis of totally vague and bald allegations of the complainant inasmuch as there was no documentary evidence, which can connect the petitioner with the allegations levelled against him.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the allegations levelled against the petitioner in the FIR.

A perusal of the FIR in question reveals that when the petitioner was confronted by the complainant for his extra marital affair with a woman, he

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abandoned her and went away after pronouncing ‘Talaq’ thrice.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and allegations levelled against the petitioner, no ground is made out to grant the anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
