ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

Mr.Ritesh Aggarwal, Advocate appears and submits that earlier learned counsel for the appellant has since been elevated to the Bench of this Court and the appellant has not made any alternative arrangements to assist this Court. Having perused the appeal paper-book alongwith the relevant record appended herewith, I am of the view that, in any case, by sheer efflux of time, the present appeal is rendered infructuous as it was way back in the year 1990 when the suit was filed for recovery of an amount of Rs.10,000/- on account of damages towards malicious prosecution. With the lapse of so many years and coupled with the fact that the concurrent findings against the plaintiff in all likelihood, the plaintiff/appellant would have lost interest in present proceeding and that is why he has not made any alternative arrangements.

In the premise, the appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with liberty to file appropriate application at later stage, in case any cause of action still survives.
