Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail in FIR No.300 dated 18.11.2019 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Mandeep Singh and against whom there were similar allegations, has been granted benefit of bail vide order dated 13.07.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench in CRM-M-16442 of 2020.
