Petitioners have filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty as they have entered into a marriage against the wishes of private respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners married each other on 24.02.2020 in Church. It is argued that the petitioners are apprehending threat from respondent Nos.4 and 5.

As per the pleadings contained in the petition, the petitioners have performed marriage in Church whereas the photographs annexed with the petition as Annexure P-3 reveals that the marriage was solemnized at temple. A perusal of the petition and the representation dated 24.02.2020 does not reveal any manner or mode of threat allegedly extended to the

petitioners. The contents of the petition do not inspire confidence.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
