AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

On 26.02.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that because of the fact that on a complaint submitted by the petitioner against respondent No. 3-Smt. Rama Mehta, petitioner as well as respondent No. 3- Smt. Rama Mehta were transferred. Petitioner has no grudge as far as the return of respondent No. 3 to the school is concerned as per the impugned order. However, her grievance is limited to the extent that since a complaint has been preferred by her, in which an enquiry has been marked, it would not be appropriate for her to serve in the school where the Principal is respondent No. 3. Prayer has, therefore, been made that she may be transferred out of that school.

Since an advance copy has been served upon the official respondents, Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 and prays for a short adjournment to seek instructions in this regard.

Prayer granted.

Adjourned to 28.02.2020.

*Operation of the impugned order dated 20.02.2020
(Annexure P-2) qua the petitioner shall remained stayed
till the next date of hearing.”*

In pursuance thereto, counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mrs. Sukhvinder Kaur Saroya, Senior Legal Advisor, who is also present in Court, makes a statement that the competent authority on the file had passed the order, whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be continued at Adarsh Senior Secondary School, Khamba, Moga.

In the light of the above, present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
