Petitioners seek issuance of directions to official respondents to investigate the matter arising out of complaint dated 25.9.2018 filed by the petitioners in a time bound manner and to take appropriate action against private respondents No.4 and 5.

Pursuant to notice of motion and grant of last opportunity to the respondents, they have filed a short reply on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 to the effect that similar complaints have been made by 300 persons against the private

respondents and the police is thoroughly investigating all the complaints. Even the petitioners have been associated on 19.8.2018 and their statements have been recorded. The police has also recovered the documents from private respondents No.4 and 5 pertaining to the petitioners and the same have been returned to the petitioners. Respondent No.4 has already been arrested by the police on 24.5.2018 and co-accused Paramjit Singh i.e. Director of respondent No.5-company is still at large. Respondent No.5 has been declared as proclaimed offender. Police is likely to file report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in the Court.

In view of reply filed by respondents No.2 and 3, grievance of the petitioners appears to have been redressed.

For the reasons recorded herein above, this petition is disposed of.
