1. Learned counsel for respondent-University states that on the basis of fact finding inquiry conducted in the year 2007, recommendation was made to take action against respondent No.5 as also other persons but admittedly no action has been taken on the same till date but now the matter will be placed before the Executive Council of the University i.e. the competent authority in the next meeting and needful would be done, in accordance with law and till such time that decision is not taken by the competent authority, the respondent-University would not make promotions to the post of Senior Professors in the department of Community Medicine.

2. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent No.5.

3. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent-university to place the report of the fact finding inquiry as well as recommendation made in respect thereto qua respondent No.5 as well as other persons before the Executive Council for decision in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible preferably in the next meeting and till such time that decision is not taken on the same, the proposal to fill up the posts of Senior Professors in the department of Community Medicine, by promotion be kept in abeyance.
