The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C') for directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to conclude the investigation of case FIR No. 93 dated 18.07.2012 registered under Sections 419 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Malout City, District Muktsar, Punjab and directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Vide order dated 17.01.2018 notice of the petition was issued to the respondents.

Mr. Parvez Chugh, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the respondent No. 4 and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

Learned State Counsel has, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh submitted that the investigation has been completed and report

under Section 173(2) of the Cr.P.C has been filed before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malout, District Muktsar Sahib.

In view of filing of the above said report, learned Counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner does not want to continue with the petition and the same may be disposed of as having become infructuous.
