Inter alia submits the dispute had been settled on 21.6.2017 when demarcation was in progress. On account of the compromise, demarcation was stopped. However, the Gram Panchayat has failed to abide by the said compromise as no final decision has been taken. Thus, demarcation deserves to be done so that the petitioner may enclose his land.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent Nos.1 and 2 and waive service. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement nor is there any requirement of issuing notice to respondent Nos.3 and 4.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1 to treat the writ petition as representation for carrying out demarcation. Appropriate order be passed thereupon, after hearing the concerned parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
