Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 227 Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass them or interfere in their married life at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

On 27.02.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, reply by way of affidavit of Pardeep Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today, wherein it is mentioned that on the complaint of respondent No.4 (father of petitioner No.1), FIR No.46 dated 25.02.2020, under Sections 363 and 366 IPC has been registered at Police Station, Chhappar.

In view of the reply filed by the State, it is evident that father of the girl has adopted a remedy in accordance with law and, therefore, the alleged threat, as claimed by the petitioners, is baseless and is not supported with any convincing material. Since petitioner No.2 is an accused in the aforementioned FIR, therefore, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extraordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
