Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 25.2.2020 in this regard to the Commissioner, District Amritsar.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age as well as photographs

(Annexure P-4) and copy of certificate (Annexure P-3) regarding performance of marriage. During the course of hearing, the petitioners have also produced self attested copies of their Matriculation certificates which are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - S.H.O., Police Station Verka, District Amritsar, that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
