Challenge in this writ petition is to the show cause notice dated 19.2.2020 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, calling upon the petitioner, the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat of Village BIR Dhandoor, Tehsil and District Hisar, Haryana, to show-cause as to why he should not be removed from office.

It is not the case of the petitioner that the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, lacks jurisdiction to issue the subject show-cause notice, in terms of Section 51(3) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994. Limited grounds would be available for challenging a show-cause notice but no such ground is made out or established in the case on hand. No jurisdictional aspect is raised in relation to the impugned show-cause notice and no allegations of malafides or pre-determined mind are made. It is for the petitioner to respond to the show-cause notice and put forth his case. Leaving it open to him to do so, the writ petition is dismissed in limine.
