The Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar has passed an order directing dispossession of the petitioner from the land in dispute. The case of the petitioner is that he is a lessee from the Punjab Wakf Board and is not in illegal occupation and thus, the order passed by the Deputy Commissioner is illegal.

2. In case an executive authority passes an illegal order, the same can be set aside only by way of appeal/revision.

3. Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to challenge the aforementioned order passed by the Deputy Commissioner.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
