Prayer in this petition is for grant of interim bail in FIR No.258 dated 10.09.2019 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his arguments to the extent that the petitioner may be granted interim bail for a period of three days to attend the marriage of his sister; functions of which are fixed for 14.03.2020 and 15.03.2020.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Kumar and on the basis of custody certificate dated 04.03.2020 filed in the Court today, has submitted that the petitioner is involved in number of cases and his earlier regular bail application was recently dismissed as withdrawn on 29.01.2020. It is further submitted that the petitioner may be directed to attend the marriage

under police custody.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of and the petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of three days subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa will release the petitioner on 13.03.2020 and will hand over his custody to the SHO/Incharge, Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa. The petitioner will stay in the police station for three days i.e. from 13.03.2020 to 15.03.2020.

The SHO/Incharge, Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa is directed to constitute a team of three police officials to take the petitioner from the police station from 08.00 a.m. to 06.00 p.m. on 14.03.2020 and 15.03.2020 to attend the marriage functions.

The custody of the petitioner will be handed over back to the Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa on 16.03.2020 by 5.00 p.m.

This will, however, be subject to the condition that the petitioner will pay a sum of Rs.6,000/- to the SHO concerned for arranging a vehicle for his transportation.

Disposed of, accordingly.
