LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner has challenged order dated 28.08.2019 (Annexure P-5), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam, as well as conditional arrest warrant issued against the petitioner.

Notice of motion in this petition was issued, by a coordinate bench, on 15.05.2020, subject to deposit of an amount of Rs.15,000/- in order to explore the possibility of an amicable resolution of the dispute. Despite, opportunities, the sum of Rs.15,000/- has not been deposited. When this matter was taken up on 27.07.2020, it was made clear that in case, sum of Rs.15,000/- is deposited within two weeks, notice will be issued to the respondent and in case, necessary steps are not taken, this petition shall stand dismissed on this count.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the orders passed in this petition have been conveyed to the petitioner, but necessary steps have not been taken.

In view of the above, there is no other option, but to dismiss this petition, for the reason as above.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
