This third petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 156 dated 18.7.2019, registered under Sections 386, 342, 332, 506, 120B IPC, at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is concocted one. The petitioner has not committed any crime, as alleged against her. Still further, it is submitted that there are total 9 accused in this case and out of them, 8 co-accused of the petitioner, including those with similar attribution, have already granted bail by different Courts. The petitioner only is in custody as of now. She is in custody since 19.7.2019. She is not required for any investigation purposes. Evidence in the case have not even been started so far. Therefore, no purpose would be served by keeping her in custody. Hence, the petitioner deserves to be released on bail.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Kumar, submits that the petitioner is directly involved in the crime. She is specifically named in the FIR and her role has also been specified. Even the material connected with the crime has been recovered from the petitioner. However, it is not denied that 8 co-accused of the petitioner have already been released on bail. It is also not disputed that no witness has been examined so far.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail pending trial on her furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
