The grievance of the petitioners is that their land has allegedly been encroached upon and despite representation dated 4.11.2019 (Annexure P-6) having been made, demarcation is not being conducted.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 only.

Ms. Monica Chhibber Sharma, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and waives service. Three copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Considering the nature of order being passed, no written statement is necessary to be filed nor is it necessary to serve respondent No.4.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 4.11.2019 and decide the same by passing a speaking order thereupon within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Demarcation, if any, is required to be done pursuant to the order passed, the same may be done within one week thereafter.
