Learned counsel for the appellants fairly states that way back in the year 2012, the appellants had taken the case file from him saying that they wish to explore the possibility of settlement with the respondents. He submits that ever since neither the case file has been returned to him nor the appellants are in touch with him in spite of letters written by the office of the learned counsel.

In the premise, this Court is of the view that by sheer efflux of time either the appellants have lost interest in appeal or in the alternative it seems that they may have settled the matter with the respondents and that is why perhaps appellants have not returned the file to the learned counsel.

Be that as it may, the regular second appeal is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the appellants to file an appropriate application, in case any cause of action still survives.
