1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing order Annexure P/6 dated 22.02.2020, transferring the petitioner contrary to the instructions Annexure P/3 dated 18.04.1980.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P/7 dated 23.02.2020 against impugned order Annexure P/6 dated 22.02.2020 to the respondent but the same has not been decided till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/7 dated 23.02.2020, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/7 dated 23.02.2020 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
