1. Regular Second Appeal was filed in the year 1992. It arose out of civil suit filed way back in the year 1986 for permanent injunction restraining the defendant from interfering into the possession of plaintiff which was decreed in favour of the plaintiff/respondent on 11.08.1990. The First Appellate Court affirmed the findings returned by the trial Court and dismissed the appeal filed by the appellant vide judgment dated 16.12.1991.

2. Case has been called twice but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the parties.

3. From sheer pendency of the appeal for more than 27 years before this Court, it seems to have been either rendered infructuous or even otherwise the appellant seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

4. Regular Second Appeal is, accordingly, disposed of as

infructuous with liberty to file an appropriate application, in case, any
cause of action still survives.
