1. Regular Second Appeal was filed in the year 1992 arising out of a civil suit filed way back in the year 1986 for possession through specific performance of agreement to sell dated 29.06.1983 which was decreed in favour of the plaintiff/respondent on 05.01.1989. The First Appellate Court affirmed the findings returned by the trial Court vide judgment dated 20.11.1991.

2. Today, case called twice but none has put in appearance on behalf of the parties.

3. Sheer pendency of the appeal for more than 28 years before this Court seems to have either rendered it infructuous or even otherwise the appellant seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

4. Regular Second Appeal is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with liberty to file an appropriate application, in case, any cause of action still survives.
