1. Regular Second Appeal herein arises out of a civil suit, which was filed way back in the year 1982 for permanent injunction restraining the defendants from interfering into the possession of the plaintiffs. The suit was dismissed on 15.06.1989. The First Appellate Court reversed the findings returned by the trial Court on 16.12.1991.

2. While admitting the present second appeal, status quo was ordered to be maintained.

3. Case has been called out twice but there is no representation on behalf of the appellants.

4. By sheer pendency of the appeal for more than 27 years before this Court seems to have either rendered it infructuous or even otherwise the appellants seem to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

5. Regular Second Appeal is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the appellants to file an appropriate application, in case any cause of action still survives.
