1. This order will dispose of CRM M- 9068 and 12144 of 2020 as both of them arise out of same FIR and the same alleged occurrence. Both the cases are taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Pandemic of COVID-19.
2. In Gobind's case, interim bail was granted by this Court vide order dated 5.3.2020. In Kuldeep Singh's case, no interim bail has been granted. Learned State counsel submits that FSL report has been received and the challan has been prepared for presentation before the trial court. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that it will take long time to complete trial.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I fail to see any material difference between the two cases. No useful purpose would be served by lingering the interim bail granted to petitioner Gobind and by keeping other petitioner Kuldeep Singh in judicial custody.

4. In view of the above, interim bail granted to petitioner-Gobind vide order dated 5.3.2020 passed by this Court is hereby confirmed. Petitioner Kuldeep Singh is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
5. Both the petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
