Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.99 dated 13.07.2016 under Sections 376-D, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (charges have been framed under Sections 376, 506 IPC and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012), registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 28.04.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the petitioner and respondent No.4 are married and are staying together as husband and wife.

The trial in the case is at advanced stage. He states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to expedite the trial.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the stage of the trial.

In the light of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, petitioner and respondent No.4 are staying together as husband and wife, but the proceedings could not go ahead for the reason that there was an interim order dated 02.05.2017, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the trial court to conclude the trial expeditiously.
