The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.297, dated 5.9.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was allegedly apprehended with 2200 intoxicated tablets brand-Clovidol containing Tramadol Hydrochloride salt. The alleged recovery falls in the 'commercial category'.

The Forensic Science Laboratory has also reported presence of salt Tramadol Hydrochloride. In view of the provisions of Section 37 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, 1985, no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Hence, dismissed. However, learned Trial Court is requested to make sincere efforts to conclude the trial of the case as

expeditiously as possible, after the normal functioning of the Court resume.
