In view of the resolution of the Bar, the Lawyers have decided to abstain from work.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') in FIR No.312 dated 22.12.2019, for offence punishable under Sections 22-B of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Custody Certificate filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per the Custody Certificate, the petitioner is not involved in any other case; challan stands presented and out of 11 PWs, none has been examined.

Though, the petitioner was apprehended at the spot with 500 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride, which falls in commercial quantity, however, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for about 11 months and 16 days and the trial is not progressing due to COVID-19 situation in the country and the custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is not required, this petition is partly allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail upto 30.04.2021 subject to his furnishing bail bonds and 02 surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail of the petitioner, in case he is found involved in any other case or misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.
