Primarily, grievance of the petitioners is to the effect that they had taken a sum of ₹11,50,000/- from respondents No. 4 and 5 and were to mortgage their property.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondents No.4 and 5 have fraudulently got executed the sale deed, whereas, the value of the property was enormous at the relevant time. He further submits that in this regard a representation, contained at Annexure P-4, has already been submitted to respondent No.2.

Without making any comment on the genuineness of allegations, as put forth in the representation, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, in accordance with law.
