This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking for quashing of FIR No. 80 dated 28.7.2015 (Annexure P/1) registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise (Annexure P/2).

It is noted that by order dated 4.5.2017, notice of motion had been issued to the respondents with a direction to the parties to get their statements recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate. A report has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sangrur, wherein it is stated that no compromise has been effected by respondent No.2.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners. Even on 7.2.2019, none had put in appearance despite having been passed over.

Consequently, the case was adjourned for 28.8.2019, when the case was adjourned by order for today.

In view of the categoric statement given by respondent No.2 that there is no compromise arrived at between the parties, no ground for interference is made out. Dismissed.
