The present petition has been filed challenging the order dated 25.03.2019 whereby the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed offenders.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners may be permitted to surrender before the trial Court within ten days and face trial and prays for protection of the petitioners, in the meanwhile.

This Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioners so far as the protection of the petitioners is concerned. It is rather duty of the petitioners to appear before the trial Court and face trial.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

However, in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within ten

days and file bail applications, the trial Court will consider the said applications on the same day, in accordance with law.
