Present petition has been filed by the petitioners-HC Raj Kumar and 12 others, *inter alia*, with the prayer to direct the respondents to count the daily wages service as Special Police Officer (SPO). Learned counsel submits that the service rendered before their respective regularization was required to be treated as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits in view of the judgment of this Court in *Harbans Lal's* case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners for this very grievance had also served a legal notice upon the respondents but the same had not been decided till date.

Without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with the directions to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners within the period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
