The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioners have filed the present writ petition *inter alia* seeking a direction not to dispense with their services by replacing them with another set of employees on account of change of service provider in terms of numerous judicial pronouncements and for grant of other reliefs.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the status report and also in view of the fact that the contract period is over, no further order is called for.

Learned counsel for the private respondent submits that his grievance still remains unaddressed. He submits that the private respondent has suffered great financial losses in the process and as such liberty be given to take the plea before the appropriate forum.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of as having become infructuous. The private respondent, if so advised, may avail its remedy as may be available in law.
