On asking of the Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Heard.

The petitioners have placed on record their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the petitioners have also produced on record copy of their marriage certificate and photographs (Annexures P-3 and P-4).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3

- S.H.O., Police Station Balachaor, District Nawanshahar, that

representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties .
