Regular Second Appeal was filed in the year 1991 arises out of a civil suit, which was filed way back in the year 1985 and was decreed in favour of the plaintiff/respondent on 12.10.1989. The First Appellate Court affirmed the findings returned by the trial Court and in the present second appeal, no stay order was granted on the judgments/decrees passed by the Courts below.

None appeared on 09.05.2017, when the case was called out for hearing and in the interest of justice, it was adjourned. Same is the position today as none appears on behalf of the parties.

By sheer pendency of the appeal for more than 28 years before this Court seems to have either rendered it infructuous or even otherwise the appellants seem to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

Regular Second Appeal is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the appellants to file an appropriate application, in case, any cause of action still survives.
