All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pursuant to the earlier order of this court, the undated report of the JMIC, Tarn Taran, has been received, stating therein that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and voluntary, of their own free will.

Though it has not been stated that the JMIC herself was satisfied that accused/petitioner Navpreet Kaur @ Navdeep Kaur is the person whom she claims to be, however that would be seem to be so as per the statement of the complainant, Hardev Singh, dated 15.10.2020, which was recorded on the same date and obviously in the presence of Navpreet Kaur @ Navdeep Kaur (whose statement is also on record).

Learned State counsel also submits, on instructions from SI Charan Singh, that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offence, the petition is allowed and FIR No.103, dated 23.07.2019, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 420 of the IPC read with Section 120-B thereof, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
