In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take appropriate action on representation dated 15.02.2019 (Annexure P-11), which has been registered bearing UID No. 1512229 dated 26.02.2019, against respondents No. 5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of instant petition would be achieved, if, respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to decide representation dated 15.02.2019 (Annexure P-11), moved by the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation Annexure P-11, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of

hearing to her, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
