In compliance of order dated 24.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced receipts of `20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.64 dated 23.01.2018, registered under Sections 406, 408, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 201 IPC, at Police Station City Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 13.11.2019 of the Coordinate Bench, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 14.01.2020 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.14 dated 14.01.2020, duly

forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Karnal, vide Endst. No.569 dated 15.01.2020.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and voluntarily in nature.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.64 dated 23.01.2018, registered under Sections 406, 408, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 201 IPC, at Police Station City Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioner with the quarters concerned.
