Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 284 dated 8.11.2019 registered at Police Station, Pinangwa, District Nuh, Mewat under Sections 398, 401 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Heard.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Haryana.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of the State of Haryana.

The petitioner is in custody since 8.11.2019. On due investigation of FIR, challan has been presented in the Court but till date none of the prosecution witnesses has been examined as the case is still pending for framing of charge. There is another criminal case registered against the petitioner in which he was released on bail. There is no allegation that the accused is likely to flee from process of justice, in case enlarged on bail.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, bail to the petitioner subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, Mewat. However, he shall abide by the following conditions:-

(i)He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and

(ii)He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
