HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the claim of the petitioner is covered by the judgement passed by this Court in CWP No.7855 of 2014 titled as **Jinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others** on 17.12.2018, but, the benefit of the said judgement is not being granted to the petitioner without any valid justification. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the only reason due to which the petitioner has not been extended the benefit is that the petitioner has not approached this Court seeking the same relief, which has been allowed to the petitioners in **Jinder Singh's case (supra)**.

Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit as extended by this Court to the petitioners in **Jinder Singh's case (supra)**.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the

respondents with legal notice dated 12.05.2019 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with them and he will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 12.05.2019 (Annexure P/7) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
