HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that once the petitioner was reinstated in service and retired on attaining the age of superannuation in July 2019, he is also entitled for the service benefit for the period, he remained out of the service, such as promotion, which was given to the persons junior to him.

Prayer of the petitioner is for the grant of benefit of promotion to the next higher rank with effect from the date, the persons junior to him have been promoted alongwith consequential benefit of revision of pay and pensionary benefits with arrears.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted representations, which have been appended with the present writ petition as Annexures P/4 to P/8, which are still pending consideration with the

respondents and he will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 26.12.2019 (Annexure P/8).

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 26.12.2019 (Annexure P/8) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
