Petitioner has filed this first petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 234 dated 26.10.2019 registered under Section 379-B and 411 of IPC, at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the occurrence took place on 26.09.2019 and the FIR has been registered on 26.10.2019. He further states that the recovery of the gold chain has been affected from the co-accused Kulwinder Singh @ Jajju. and the same has been released on

sapurdari to the complainant.

On the instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, learned State counsel submits that the charge has been framed and the prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.

Though the name of the petitioner specifically mentioned in the FIR but the FIR in question was registered after one month of the occurrence and in the FIR it has been stated that the investigation was done by the complainant at her own level.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
