It has been stated that both the petitioners have attained the age for a valid marriage. The marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 01.03.2020. Copy of Adhar Card, marriage certificate and photographs are on record. The petitioners are stated to be residing at village Deogarh, Devgarh, Tehsil and District Patiala. Apprehending danger to their lives and liberty at the instance of the private respondents who are the relatives of the petitioners, the present petition has been instituted. The allegations are also substantiated with the affidavits of the petitioners.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Balbir Singh Sewak, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to him during the course of day.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into the matter and if he finds that apprehension of danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners is

real, he shall take appropriate steps to ensure their protection as he feels necessary, in such circumstances of the case.

This order is not to be construed as any opinion with regard to the age of the petitioners or factum or validity of their marriage or any civil or criminal proceedings.
