The petitioner was awarded the contract of Transport Contractor for transportation of food grains from the rail head to various storage points for two years. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the work allotted to the petitioner for the period 11.04.2016 to 10.04.2018, was carried out to the satisfaction of the respondent, but the security deposited, pursuant to letter dated 15.11.2019, Annexure P-12, is not being released in an illegal and unjustified manner, despite legal notice, being served upon the respondent.

At this stage, Mr. K.K.Gupta, Advocate, learned counsel representing the respondent-FCI, submits that the complete documents, particularly the proper 'No Due Certificate', has not been submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, though denies the same, submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to submit the same yet again, as per requirement raised by the respondent. The needful, it is submitted, shall be done by the petitioner within ten days.

Learned counsel for the respondent, submits that in case, the required documents are submitted by the petitioner, the matter shall be considered and necessary action, as called for, in accordance with law, shall be taken within three weeks.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above and in view of the respondent's stand, it is directed that, in case, the requisite documents are submitted by the petitioner within two weeks, necessary action, be taken by the respondent, within a period of three weeks thereafter. In case, the amount in question is found due towards the petitioner, the same be released within three weeks thereafter.

This writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
