The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Gurugram for an expeditious and time bound disposal of the complaint titled as ***Aditi Arora Mukerjee Versus Shubhro Jyoti Mukerjee and others.***

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the respondent has filed the aforesaid complaint under Section 12 read with Sections 18 to 23 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Gurugram on 10.05.2016 and the petitioner is made to face trial in the said complaint. He refers to the various zimni orders passed by learned Magistrate to contend that despite availing six last opportunities in the last two years, the respondent has not led her evidence for which the petitioner is being made to suffer

unnecessary harassment. He states that the limited prayer of the petitioner is to expedite the trial in the complaint so filed by the respondent.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of the respondent and without observing anything on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that the aforesaid complaint is pending since 10.05.2016, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial in the aforesaid complaint expeditiously and preferably within one year from today.
